

The College is located at Rajbari, under Patharkandi Sub-Division of Sribhumi (Karimganj) District in the State of Assam. It is situated about 364 K.Ms away from the state Capital, Guwahati. The exact Location of the college is 0.5 KM away from NH-44 (Assam-Tripura Highway Road). The main road of the college has a direct linkage with NH-44 and just before reaching the Patharkandi Town. One can reach the college by Road, Rail and Air. The nearby Airport is in Kumbirgram, about 112 K.Ms away from the college. Both rail and road communication have direct connection with Patharkandi town. COURSES OFFERED IN THE COLLEGE

Presently, the college is offering two full time Teachers' Training Programs viz-

- i. Bachelor of Education -B.Ed. recognized by NCTE, NewDelhi and Affiliated to Assam University, Silchar with 100 intake capacity (2 Units).
- ii. Diploma in Elementary Education- D.El.Ed. (Pre-Service)
 recognized by NCTE, New Delhi and Affiliated to SCERT,
 Assam with 50 intake capacity (1 Unit).

ABOUT BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (B.ED.) PROGRAMME:

The Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) programme is a professional course aims to prepare teachers both in-service and pre-service to deal with effectively the students ranging from Upper Primary to Higher Secondary Classes i.e. from Class VI-XII.

DURATIONOFTHECOURSE:

The duration of the course shall be of two academic years, divided in to Four Semesters, which can be completed in a maximum of three years duration from the date of admission to the programme.

WORKINGDAYS:

- $\mbox{\ \ (a)}\mbox{\ \ }$ There shall be at least 90 110 working days in each semester exclusive of the examinations days.
- (b) The institution shall work for a minimum of thirty-six hours in a week, during which physical presence in the institution of all teachers and student teachers is necessary to ensure their availability for, advice, guidance, dialogue and consultation as and when needed.
- (c) The minimum attendance of student-teachers shall have to be85% for all class work and practicum and 95% for school internship.

INTAKE&ELIGIBILITY:

- (i) **Intake:**TheCollegeishaving100intakecapacitywithtwounitsof50 students each.
- (ii) Eligibility: A Candidates with at least fifty percent marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and /or in the Master's Degree in Sciences/Social Sciences/Humanities/ Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the B.Ed. Programme.
- (iii) The reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/EWS and other categories shall be maintained as per the Central Government/StateGovernment/Affiliating University rules, whichever is applicable.

N.B:

B.Ed. Fourth Semester is solely dedicated for school related activities so as to enable the prospective teachers well acquainted with the routine functioning of a school and to develop them as competent teachers who can meet and support for the overall development of individual children.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

To build up character, emotional integration with the society and to supplement and complement the class room teachings, the college provides exposure of studentson compulsory basis to various activities like games and sports, observation of different days of local, national & international importance, cleanliness and decoration of the college campus, educational tour (excursion) to various Historical places, different cultural and literary activities etc.

Besides, the trainees are also engaged in Community work, organize Awareness programmes, Literary and Cultural in the neighboring villages from time to time.

ADMISSION PROCESS/GUIDELINES FOR B.ED. ADMISSION:

The eligible candidate for admission in to the B.Ed. Course may apply online by visiting https://ausexamination.ac.in, the website of Assam University, Silchar. (No offline application will be entertained in the college).

The eligible candidates will be issued Admit Card by the University to appear in the Common Admission Test-CAT and a College wise Merit List will be prepared by the University based on academic percentage in Graduation/Post Graduation(Qualifying Examination) and the marks obtained in the CAT.

Admission will be offered to those candidate/s whose name appeared in the Category wise Merit List prepared by the University.

SCHEDULE OF ADMISSION:

- i. Generally, the online application process begins in the month of May every Year. The applicants may get 2 to 3 weeks' time to apply.
- ii. Following the applications, the same will be scrutinize by the respective colleges and if found everything is ok, then approved.
- iii. Subsequently, the university will notify the date of CAT and issue Admit Card to the eligible candidates.
- iv. The candidates are required to select their specific exam centers before issuing the Admit Card by the University using their log in credentials.
- v. The students who are appearing the final semester examinations and are willing to apply, may apply choosing APPEARED candidate options. In this case, the appeared candidates will be allowed to appear the CAT, but must have to produce Final Result of Graduation/ Post Graduation on or before the stipulated date (Notify by the University in due course of time) for preparation of Merit List. In case of failure, such candidates name will not include in the Merit List and hence not eligible for admission.
- vi. The tentative date of CAT will be in the 1stWeek of August (Sunday)and the Admission from the Merit List will be completed approximately by the 3rdweek of August and the Classes will be commence from the last week of August or from the 1stof Sept.
